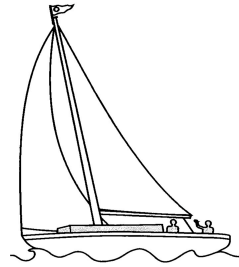

What to bring on the Norfolk Broads Cruise

Space on the yachts is at a premium so please do not bring too much. It must be packed in a squashy bag which can then be folded up and put out of the way during the week.

You **MUST** bring at least:

Pyjamas/nightdress etc.

A warm sleeping bag and pillowcase (pillow provided)

Washing kit and towel (shaver sockets available)

3 sets of thick, warm clothes

Bin liners for storing dry clothes

Proper waterproofs (including trousers)

Old gloves for handling ropes (plastic garden gloves over thin woollen gloves work well for some)

Bible

2 pairs of trainers / pumps etc.

Woolly hat or similar

Torch

It is not essential but you **MAY** like to bring:

Another set of clothes in case of emergencies

Sailing boots... but not Wellingtons as they are unsafe aboard a yacht

A de-shackler or marlinespike to help with the rigging of the boats

A camera or binoculars to see and record the sights and wildlife

Spending money – we recommend about £10 - £20 plus anything for “regalia” which will be on sale during the week

RYA level 1 and 2 log book if you already have started one

But please do **NOT** bring:

Personal audio equipment such as an iPod. These are antisocial in the context of a cruise with lots of other people and can be dangerous. In addition, we do not want people to bring anything too valuable in case it gets wet, lost or damaged.
